The direct health care services encompass the practice of Family Nurse Practitioner position. This includes diagnosis, prevention and treatment of injuries, diseases, physician examination, evaluations assessments and referrals.

- 1. Must be currently License in the United States as an Advanced Registered Nurse Practitioner with prescriptive authority.
