Background

The Skokomish Indian Tribe is issuing a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for interest in performing work for the Skokomish Tribal Court as Tribal Prosecutors. This position requires that the applicant have a current bar license in at least one U.S. state. Experience in American Indian law is desired. Scope of the work will include:

Scope

The Prosecutor position is a part-time contract position that envisions the applicant working in person at the tribe for 18 hours a week. As part of the position, the Prosecutor will:

- Represents the Tribe in all criminal, civil, infractions, juvenile, dependency, guardianship, appellate, housing, and other matters before the tribe's courts.
- Assists the Tribe's School Attendance Officer in School Attendance/Truancy matters brought to the Tribal Court.
- Develop policies supporting alternative sentencing options (including diversions, stipulated orders of continuance, and deferred prosecution agreements) based on restorative and rehabilitative justice models.
- Develop and enforce further policies and procedures as necessary to ensure the efficient and effective operations of the Prosecutor's Office.
- Oversee the revision of the Skokomish code and ordinances.

Contract Duration: February 1, 2025, to September 30, 2027

Evaluation

This position requires prior experience in criminal law, and dependency law is desired. Pay will be determined based on experience and prior record.
