REPRESENTATIVE DUTIES INCLUDE: As a professional community outreach staff, this position will serve as lead in developing a coordinated community response to domestic violence including intervention and prevention activities. This position will work with the community to develop and implement education and prevention campaigns design to inform the community about domestic violence, dating violence, sexual and stalking and increases awareness about the needs of children who witness domestic violence. Provides community education and information through direct services, community activities and media; provides support groups and organizes and leads women's circle and other outreach and prevention activities. Must adhere to the policies and procedures of Tuwaduq Family Services and the Skokomish Tribe. Must be familiar with victim advocacy and Social Services processes. Provides support groups, cultural activities, women's circle, and other duties as assigned.
