LEGAL GEAR: HOOK AND LINE ONLY: A SINGLE LINE TO WHICH NO MORE THAN TWO SINGLE-POINT BARBED HOOKS MAY BE ATTACHED. TREBLE HOOKS ARE NOT LEGAL GEAR. (EXCLUDING DRIFT OR SET NETS, BEACH SEINES, POLE GAFFS, RING NETS AND EXPLOSIVES) AS PER THE SKOKOMISH FISHING ORDINANCE SECTION 7.02.084.

OTHER RESTRICTIONS: 1) ALL FISH POSSESSED BY A FISHER MUST BE AT LEAST 12 INCHES IN LENGTH.
2) DAILY CATCH LIMIT OF 5 FISH PER FISHER.
3) ALL STEELHEAD AND OTHER SALMON MUST BE RELEASED INTO THE CREEK UNHARMED.
4) ALL FISHERS MUST HAVE A TRIBAL SUBSISTENCE CARD IN THEIR POSSESSION.

JUSTIFICATIONS: PROVIDE A SUBSISTENCE FISHERY FOR THE HARVEST OF AVAILABLE ANADROMOUS TROUT SPECIES.
