

## CALL FOR SEALED BIDS

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by the Skokomish Indian Tribe at the Office of Community Development located at the Skokomish Tribal Center, 80 N. Tribal Center Rd., Skokomish, WA 98584 up to the hour of 12:00 p.m. on Friday June 27, 2025 for the Skok. T3ba'das Waterline Project and will then be opened and publicly read.

The project provides for the Installation of 9,150 L.F. of watermain with valves, hydrants, a pressure reducing valve and other required appurtenances to connect two existing water systems. Installation will require directional drilling under SR101 and inside the WSDOT ROW and under the paved shoulder other work, all in accordance with the attached Contract Plans, these Contract Provisions, and the Standard Specifications. This project is partially federally funded through the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

All bids shall be submitted on the prescribed Bid Forms and in the manner as stated in this advertisement and in the Bid Document. A bid security is required.

Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope with the outside clearly marked "sealed bid" with the bid opening date and time, and the project name as it appears in this advertisement and the name and address of the bidder.

Free-of-charge access to project bid documents (plans, specifications, addenda, and Bidders List) is provided to Prime Bidders, Subcontractors, and Vendors by going to [www.bxwa.com](http://www.bxwa.com) and clicking on "Posted Projects", "Public Works", and "Skokomish Indian Tribe". The range of the Engineer's opinion of probable construction cost is: \$2,500,000 to \$2,700,000. A 5% bid bond is required.
