

Seeking Hybrid In-Office/Telehealth Mental Health Providers

The Skokomish Indian Tribe is seeking a well-qualified and experienced Mental Health Counselor (LMHC), Marriage and Family Therapist (LMFT) and or Independent Clinical Social Worker (LICSW) to provide counseling with a hybrid work schedule via telehealth/in office.

We are looking for individuals to provide contracted mental health counseling via telehealth/in the office for twenty to forty hours a week (flexible based on your availability). Work time can be split between in the office and telehealth depending on availability. The anticipated hourly rate is \$80 per hour for sessions and \$50 per hour for no shows and/or administrative time.

REPRESENTATIVE DUTIES:

1. Conduct assessments, screening, and intake as needed to accommodate individuals' access to services.
2. Makes follow-up referrals for appropriate care coordination.
4. Establishes effective individual service plans.
5. Provides individual, family, and group psychotherapy.
6. Provides psychoeducation and consultations for individuals, families, community, and other providers.
7. Coordinates case management as needed for clients.
8. Monitors client's compliance with recommended treatment and makes reports accordingly.
9. Completes all clinical documentation in a timely manner in the Electronic Health Record.
10. Maintains professional standards as required by state, federal, and local laws and regulations, including abiding by HIPAA.
11. Submits detailed invoices in alignment with Skokomish Goods and Services contract.

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Master's Degree required in counseling or related discipline (required).
2. Active Washington State license as a mental health counselor or licensed independent clinical social worker, or licensed marriage and family therapist (required).
*Associates with work experience will be considered.
3. Experience or the ability to provide effective counseling utilizing telehealth (required).
4. Completion of Washington State required telehealth provider training (required).
5. Experience working with at risk and hard-to-reach populations (preferred)
6. Experience working with electronic health records (required)
7. Understanding of and sensitivity to the particular problems faced by the Native American community (highly preferred)

CONTRACT

A Skokomish Goods and Services contract will be negotiated between the successful proposer and the Tribe. The initial performance period will be for one year.
